

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS
KATY RICE BELT TASO BASKETBALL OFFICIALS ASSOCIATION

GOOD STANDING REQUIREMENTS

The member must be a registered TASO official.

All members must attend 50% of the meetings, including the required Coaches and Officials Meeting.

Official must work a minimum of 1 scrimmage per season.

Official must of taken and scored 70 or above on TASO Rules and 2 Person mechanics test for sub-varsity games.

Official must of taken and scored 80 or above on TASO Rules, 2 and 3 Person mechanics test for varsity games.

The official must be up to date on all chapter dues, state dues, and assigning fees.

It is highly recommended that officials attend as many meetings as as possible and work as many scrimmages as possible.

ADDITIONAL CREDIT FOR MEETING ATTENDANCE

An official that provides documentation that they attended an approved summer training camp will be given one meeting credit for the year they attended the camp to be in good standing.

Excludes Katy Rice Belt Fall League camps. That will count for Camp credit but each session attended will count for a meeting credit.

An official that attends the state meeting in person and attends all sessions will be given 2 meeting credits to be in good standing.

Meeting credits can be adjusted by the board before each season.

VARSITY GAME REQUIREMENT

In order to be assigned a varsity game, you must also

- Get your TASO required educational credit by doing one of the following:
 - Attend state meeting,
 - attend regional meeting,
 - complete the TASO online education modules in TASO members portal
- State Test: score 80 or above on all 3 TASO test (Rules, 2& 3 Person mechanics test)
- Be in good standing with Katy Rice Belt chapter and State TASO association.
