## BOARD, CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS APRIL 2024 BOARD ELECTION

- President, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer-Assignor
  - Calvin Harris, President (2026)
  - Kyle Turney, Vice-President (2026)
  - Darwin Phillips, Secretary-Treasurer-Assignor (2026)
- Board of Directors
  - Ed Collopy (2026)

  - Marcus Lacy (2027)







- a) The association has established the following fines and penalties:
  - A member canceling a Varsity Game assigned and having been accepted shall pay a fine of \$5.00 per game.
  - A member canceling a Sub-Varsity or Middle School Game assigned and having been accepted shall pay a fine of \$3.00 per game.
  - 3) Fifteen dollars (\$15) per game for failing to appear at a contracted game(s) and twenty five dollars (\$25) per game for the second offense. The second offense will also eliminate that official from being eligible for post season play. The official may request a hearing before the board to be reconsidered.
  - 4) Five dollars (\$5) fine for canceling a game within 12 hours of game time and a (\$7.50) within 6 hours of game time. Note sickness and work-related issues will be taken into consideration on an exception basis.
  - 5) If four of these fines are encountered during the year the official will not be eligible for post season games.





## BOARD, CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS ARTICLE XIV FINES AND PENALTIES

- How many allowances to allow before fining?
  - 3, enforcement will be consistent.
- What is the collection process?
  - PayPal, Venmo, CashApp, or Cash
- What happens if fee not paid within 7 days?
  - Officials shall be removed from upcoming games., or
  - This is more work for assignor... ACCOUNTABILITY





## OFFICIALS INFORMATION ABUSE OF OFFICIALS – INCIDENT REPORTS

- Notify Calvin & Darwin as quickly as possible after the Incident
- Why file an Incident Report?
  - Allows UIL and TAPPS to monitor the conduct of their member schools.
  - Allows UIL and TAPPS to enforce expectations
- When should an Incident Report be filed?
  - File Incident Report within 24-hours









## OFFICIALS INFORMATION HOUSE BILL 2484 & 2989

- SB 2484
- If a sports official is assaulted by a spectator at a UIL sports event, the school district MUST restrict the spectator from attending future UIL athletic contests for a period from one to five years.
- SB 2929
- A verbal warning and persisting in inappropriate behavior are not required under Subsections (a)(2)(A) and (B) for a person serving as a referee, judge, or other official of an extracurricular athletic activity or competition sponsored or sanctioned by the school district or the University Interscholastic League to eject a spectator from the extracurricular athletic activity or competition.

- Test Format
  - (All Officials) Rules Exam 50 Questions
  - Sub-Varsity Mechanics (2-person) 30 Questions
  - Varsity Mechanics (2-person/3-person) 30 Questions







- Pass Exams with a 70 or above
  - Rules Exam
  - Sub-Varsity or Varsity Mechanics Exam
- Complete TASO Approved Training
  - New Member Online Training\*, or
  - TASO State Meeting, or
  - Online Clinic, or

- Pass Exams with an 80 or above
  - Rules Exam
  - Varsity Mechanics Exam
- Complete TASO Approved Training

# OFFICIALS INFORMATION QUALIFY FOR PLAYOFFS (1 OF 2)

- State Criteria
  - All Varsity Requirements
  - Plus the following
    - Exams scores must be 90% or above (by October 31st)
    - Meet Katy Rice Belt Playoff Criteria\*

 Note: Just because you qualify for a Playoff game, does not guarantee you will get a Playoff game.







- Katy Rice Belt Playoff Criteria
  - Attended an approved summer training camp during last 4 years. (2021-2024)
  - You must work at least two scrimmages.
  - You must work at least 25 varsity contests, with at least 15 being varsity nights excluding tournaments.
  - Attend a minimum of 8 Katy Rice Belt meetings.
  - Work a minimum of 4 JH nights.
  - All fees paid on time!
  - Wear proper TASO uniform throughout the season—shoes, socks, pants, shirts, and whistles.

## OFFICIATING INCOME SAMPLE GAME FEE INCOME

- Games (60)
  - 30 Sub-Varsity (7 minute clock)
  - 20 Jr. High (6 minute clock)
  - 10 Jr. High (7 minute clock)
- Income (\$3200)
  - 30 x \$60 = \$1800
  - 20 x \$45 = \$ 900
  - 10 x \$50 = \$ 500
- Fees
  - Pre-Assigning Fee: \$100
  - Game Fees: \$3200
  - Assigning Fee: \$144
  - Amount Owed: \$44 to assigner (\$144 \$100)
